1. Introduction

YouthPropel ("YouthPropel", "we", "our", or "us") is an independent student-led initiative founded to provide educational, leadership, and career development opportunities for students worldwide.

We are committed to protecting the privacy of everyone who interacts with our website and programmes. This Privacy Policy explains what information we collect, why we collect it, how we use it, and the choices available to you.

2. Information We Collect

Depending on your interaction with YouthPropel, we may collect:

- Full name
- Grade or year level
- School name
- School address
- City and country
- Student email address
- Parent or guardian email address
- Student photograph
- Short biography
- Programme participation records
- Webinar attendance
- Feedback submitted to YouthPropel
- Any information voluntarily provided through forms, email, or other communications

We may also collect limited technical information such as browser type, device type and website usage statistics.

3. How We Use Your Information

Your information is used to:

- Administer the YouthPropel Ambassador Programme
- Verify registrations
- Communicate programme updates
- Organise webinars and events
- Maintain ambassador records
- Recognise participating students and schools
- Publish approved ambassador profiles on the YouthPropel website
- Improve YouthPropel programmes and services
- Respond to enquiries

4. Information Published on Our Website

With your consent, YouthPropel may publish:

- Student name
- Grade
- School name
- City and country
- Student photographs or other digital media
- Ambassador level
- Awards or recognition received within YouthPropel
- Any information voluntarily provided through forms, email, or other communications

Sensitive personal information such as personal email addresses or phone numbers will never be published.

5. Consent

Students registering for YouthPropel confirm that:

- They have obtained permission from their parent or legal guardian where required.
- They have obtained any necessary permissions from their school.
- The information provided is accurate.

6. Sharing Information

YouthPropel does not sell personal information.

Information may only be shared with:

- YouthPropel volunteers involved in programme administration
- Advisory Board members where required
- Technology providers supporting website or programme operations
- Authorities where legally required

7. Data Security

We take reasonable administrative and technical measures to safeguard personal information from unauthorised access, disclosure or misuse.

While we strive to protect information, no online system can guarantee complete security.

8. Data Retention

Information will be retained only for as long as necessary to administer the programme, maintain historical records of ambassadors and comply with applicable legal obligations.

9. Your Rights

Participants may request to:

- Correct inaccurate information
- Update their profile
- Withdraw website publication consent
- Request deletion of personal information where appropriate

Such requests may be submitted by contacting YouthPropel.

10. Children's Privacy

YouthPropel programmes are intended for secondary school students.

Where participants are minors, YouthPropel expects parental or guardian permission before participation.
